Teacher's Guide

- **Focus Skill:** Recognizing and correcting misuse of **few/fewer** (for countable nouns) and **less** (for uncountable nouns).
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide a quick review list of common countable and uncountable nouns before students begin.
 - For learners needing support, highlight the noun in each sentence and discuss whether it can be counted.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students read incorrect sentences aloud dramatically before rewriting them correctly.
 - Turn this into a "Correction Race": groups compete to find and fix errors fastest.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask advanced students to write two new sentences that challenge typical patterns (for example, "less than ten miles").
 - Encourage students to explain the logic behind each correction, deepening grammatical awareness.
