3. She added **less** sugar to make the cake healthier.
4. We found **few** coins under the couch cushions.
5. The teacher gave us **less** homework this weekend.

(Any correct sentences using **few** with countable nouns and **less** with uncountable nouns are acceptable.)

Teacher's Guide

- **Focus Skill:** Applying **few** and **less** accurately by identifying **countable** and **uncountable** nouns.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide a mini-lesson on countable vs. uncountable nouns before the activity.
 - Allow struggling learners to orally brainstorm sentences first with a partner.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Create a "Word Bank Race" where students compete to use all nouns correctly in creative sentences.
 - Let students illustrate one of their sentences to visually show the noun's quantity.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have advanced students add adjectives or adverbs to expand their sentences.
 - Encourage learners to exchange papers and check one another's use of **few** and **less**, explaining their reasoning.
