Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Reinforces the comparative use of **fewer** and **less** when describing differences between groups or amounts.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Review the concept of **countable** vs. **uncountable** nouns before students begin.
 - For struggling learners, underline the nouns first and ask if they can be counted out loud.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Create a "Class Comparison" activity where students make their own sentences comparing classroom data (e.g., "Our group has fewer books than theirs").
 - Have students act as "data reporters" summarizing fun comparisons between school subjects or activities.
- **Extension Ideas:**
 - Challenge students to write a short paragraph comparing two topics of their choice using both determiners correctly.
 - Use real statistics (like school recycling or sports scores) to make the comparisons meaningful and current.
