

## Critical Fill-ins Answer Key

### Sample Solutions

1. **practical/realistic/feasible** - Critical evaluation: Was the garden a workable idea?
2. **drawbacks/challenges/costs** - Connecting arguments: weighing positives vs. negatives.
3. **innovation/leadership/initiative** - Conclusion: A greenhouse would show problem-solving and creativity.

### Teacher Notes / Guide

- This activity pushes students beyond recall to **analysis and evaluation**.
- Accept a range of reasonable answers (e.g., "practical" or "feasible" for Blank 1).
- Encourage students to justify their answers: *"I chose 'innovation' because building a greenhouse shows creativity."*
- Extension: Students can write a one-paragraph recommendation for whether the school should approve the garden, using cause-and-effect reasoning.
