- 1. **decided** Past tense matches "last summer."
- 2. **a** Indefinite article fits since it is "a map," not previously mentioned.
- 3. they Pronoun referring to Amelia and Ethan.
- 4. was Past tense needed for "realized the compass was missing."
- 5.  $can \rightarrow could$  Past tense of ability is required ("I think we could find...").
- 6. they Pronoun subject, matches plural.
- 7. there "There lay a dusty compass..." introduces existence/location.
- 8. was Past tense matches the story.

## **Teacher Notes / Guide**

- This passage emphasizes verb tense consistency and appropriate pronoun/article usage in context.
- Students may be tempted to use present tense (e.g., "is" instead of "was"),
  but encourage them to rely on time markers like last summer to guide their answers.
- Extension: Have students rewrite the passage in present tense or future
  tense, changing all verbs and adjusting pronouns/articles as needed.
