Teacher's Guide

- **How to use:** Say the target word clearly, then have students repeat it. Tell students to listen for the **ending sound** and choose the option that matches that ending sound.
- **Differentiate:** For support, read both choices aloud and exaggerate the ending sounds; students can echo-read before checking. For challenge, ask students to write a third word that rhymes with the target after they check the box.
- **Engagement:** Let students use a "quiet voice" to test both choices, then do a quick partner share to confirm. Add a class signal: students touch their ear when they hear the rhyme.
- **Extension:** Have students pick four targets and sort them into two rhyme families (for example, -at and -og). Then students read each family list aloud with smooth, accurate speech.
