Teacher's Guide

- **How to use:** Read the target word, then have students repeat it and tap the last sound before choosing. Remind them that rhyming words have the same ending sound.
- **Differentiate:** For support, cover two choices and start with just two options; say both aloud and ask, "Which one sounds the same at the end?" For challenge, ask students to say one more word that rhymes with the target after they circle the answer.
- **Engagement:** Let students whisper the words into a "sound phone" (a cupped hand) before circling. Use quick check-ins like "Thumbs up if it rhymes!"
- **Extension:** Have students draw a quick sketch of the target word and the rhyming word they circled, then read the pair aloud to a partner using a clear voice and correct ending sounds.
