### Teacher's Guide

- **How to use:** Read the target word aloud, then have students repeat it and listen for the **ending sound**. Read each choice aloud and ask, "Which one sounds the same at the end?"
- **Differentiate:** For support, cover one choice so students pick from two options first; then uncover the third option. For challenge, ask students to say one more word that rhymes with the target after they color.
- **Engagement:** Use a quick routine: "Say it, tap it, pick it, color it." Let students use crayons for rhymes and a different color to lightly X out non-rhymes.
- **Extension:** After coloring, have students draw a simple picture of the target word next to the rhyming picture and say the pair as a **rhyme duo** to a partner.
