Teacher's Guide

- **How to use:** Have students say the first word, then stretch the ending sound (for example, cat, at). Remind them that rhyming words have the **same ending sound**, not the same first sound.
- **Differentiate:** For support, read each row aloud and have students point to the rhyming choice before underlining. For challenge, ask students to write one more rhyming word next to the row after they underline the answer.
- **Engagement:** Turn each item into a quick call and response: "Target word!" students repeat, then "Find the rhyme!" and they underline. Let students use a highlighter for the rhyme word after checking with a partner.
- **Extension:** After completing the page, have students choose three targets and make a short **rhyming chant** by reading the pair (cat-hat) aloud with a steady beat.
