Question #	Strong, Revised Answer with Evidence
1	According to the passage , bees are important because “they play a crucial role in pollination, transferring pollen between flowers so plants can produce fruits and seeds.” This process helps crops like apples and strawberries grow successfully.
2	The text explains that bees are disappearing due to “pesticides, habitat loss, and disease.” These environmental issues make it harder for bees to survive and reproduce.
3	The author states that “scientists and farmers are working together to create bee-friendly gardens and reduce harmful chemicals,” showing how people are helping bees recover.
4	In the passage , the author connects bees to a larger idea by saying, “Protecting bees means protecting the balance of our entire food system.” This shows that bees are vital for maintaining environmental health.

Teaching Tips:

- Begin by showing two sample answers: one weak, one strong, and have students identify what makes the strong one better (specificity, quotes, and proof).
- Encourage students to use short, meaningful quotes instead of copying large chunks of text.

Assessment Tip: Award full credit only if the answer shows both understanding of the passage and correct citation use.
