Sample Proof Paragraph:

Teaching Tips:

- Model the first evidence selection as a class. Highlight the sentence in the text and discuss why it's strong.
- Emphasize that **strong evidence is specific and supports the claim directly**, while weak evidence might be off-topic or opinion-based.
- Teach transitions for integrating evidence (e.g., *One example is...*, *Another reason...*, *This shows that...*).
- For differentiation, allow struggling writers to use the sentence frame; advanced students can create their own claim and locate new evidence.
