Teacher's Guide

You may instruct your students to use the prompts below to guide their responses:

1. Finn:

- What are Finn's most defining traits?
- What motivates his actions toward Huck and others?
- Does Finn change over the course of the story, or does he remain the same?

2. Huck:

- What do Huck's actions reveal about his values?
- How does his relationship with Finn shape his growth?
- Where do we see Huck questioning or resisting authority?

3. Supporting Character (Your Choice):

- Which character did you choose, and why?
- What role do they play in shaping Finn or Huck's journey?
- What changes (or lack of change) define them by the story's end?

Write your answers in full paragraphs. Support your ideas with **specific examples, details, or quotes** from the text. Think critically about whether each character grows, struggles, or stays fixed in their ways.

Students' responses will vary. Encourage students to write at least 5-7 sentences per character.
