4. Art - Bad Prompt: Tell me about art.

- **For Kids:** Explain what art is, with examples like painting, music, and dance, and why people enjoy creating it.
- **For Experts:** Analyze how modern art movements challenge traditional definitions of creativity and aesthetics.
- **For General Readers:** Describe different types of art, why people make it, and how it can express ideas or emotions.
