### Sample Responses

1. **Patriotism** - Love and devotion to one's country.  
*Sentence:* The students showed patriotism by singing the national anthem at the Flag Day assembly.
2. **Emblem** - A symbol or design that represents an idea or group.  
*Sentence:* The American flag is an emblem of freedom and bravery.
3. **Heritage** - Traditions and values passed down from past generations.

4. **Unity** - The state of being joined together for a common purpose.
