## Phrasing With Flow Answer Key

1. **Morning clues:** "The morning sun peeked over the hills," and "Birds began to sing" suggest the start of the day.

*Teacher Note:* Reinforces literal comprehension.

2. **Sensory details:** Sight → golden light, sparkling fountain; Sound → birds singing, water splashing; Smell → warm bread.

*Teacher Note:* Guides students to recognize how authors build imagery.

3. **Reason for berries/bread:** They are preparing for a feast, which implies a community celebration.

*Teacher Note:* This is inferential – not directly stated, but strongly implied.

4. **Mood:** Cheerful, peaceful, joyful. Words like *cheerful melodies, sparkled, laughter, celebrating together* create this effect.

*Teacher Note:* Builds evaluative and interpretive thinking.
