

Club Meeting Rewrite Answer Key

Answers will vary. Example:

Liam: I'm getting a little bored, but maybe we can take turns sharing our ideas to make this faster.

Ava: Good idea. Let's focus on what we still need to finish.

Noah: I'll put my phone away so I can help plan the posters.

Jordan: Thanks, everyone. Working together will make this event go well.

Teacher's Guide:

- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide sentence starters like "I feel...", "Let's try...", or "Can we...?" to guide respectful phrasing.
 - Allow students to act out the rewrite verbally before writing it down.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have pairs perform both versions of the script and ask the class which sounded more respectful and why.
 - Discuss what unspoken rules were followed in the improved version (e.g., listening, patience, polite tone).
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to write their own short script showing a misunderstanding that is resolved respectfully.
 - Encourage a reflection paragraph: "Why is respectful communication important in group settings?"
