Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Reinforces how **for** is used to express a length of time and **since** is used to mark a starting point in time.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For struggling learners, model a few examples aloud ("I've lived here for five years" vs. "I've lived here since 2019").
 - Allow students to create gestures or visual cues (a clock for "for," a calendar for "since").
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Turn it into a game by saying a time phrase aloud and having students call out or hold up "for" or "since."
 - Encourage pairs to make up new time phrases for their classmates to solve.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Have students write three original sentences using **for** and three using **since**.
 - Challenge advanced learners to explain why a phrase uses **for** or **since** in full sentences.
