Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Strengthens understanding of when to use **for** to describe a length of time and **since** to describe a starting point in time.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Offer visual aids (timeline for **for**, starting point marker for **since**) for visual learners.
 - Pair students so they can discuss their reasoning before writing corrections.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Play "Time Detective" where students find and fix errors read aloud by the teacher.
 - Have students create their own incorrect sentences and swap with a partner to correct.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Ask students to write three new sentences using **for** and three using **since** correctly.
 - Challenge advanced learners to explain in their own words why each correction is needed.
