Teacher's Guide

- Remind students to identify the fraction and the whole number before choosing an expression.
- Encourage students to explain why the other choices do not match the situation.
- Support students by highlighting the words "of" as a clue for finding a fraction of a number.
- Let students work with a partner to justify their expression choices before solving.
- Increase engagement by asking students to write a short story for one of the correct expressions after completing the worksheet.
- Extend learning by having students create two new scenarios and three expression choices for each, with only one correct answer.
