Teacher's Guide

- Have students count the total number of objects before finding the fraction.
- Remind students to divide the set into equal groups based on the denominator, then count the required number of groups.
- Provide counters or linking cubes for students who benefit from hands-on practice.
- Encourage students to explain how they found each answer using the words denominator, numerator, and equal groups.
- Let partners check each other's work by grouping the objects in different ways and confirming the same result.
- Extend learning by asking students to draw their own sets and write a fraction for a classmate to solve.
