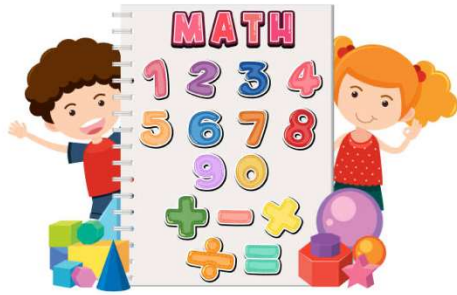

3. A ribbon is $\frac{7}{8}$ yard long. Emma used $\frac{3}{8}$ yard for a craft. How much ribbon is left?

4. Noah read $\frac{1}{4}$ of a book on Monday and $\frac{2}{4}$ of the same book on Tuesday. What fraction of the book did he read in all?

5. Ava baked 12 muffins. She gave $\frac{1}{3}$ of them to a neighbor. How many muffins did she give away?

6. A class has 20 students. $\frac{3}{5}$ of the students wore sneakers. How many students wore sneakers?

7. Ben picked $\frac{4}{6}$ of a basket of apples. His sister picked $\frac{1}{6}$ of the basket. What fraction of the basket did they pick altogether?

8. A rope is $\frac{9}{10}$ meter long. Carlos cut off $\frac{2}{10}$ meter. How much rope is left?

9. Olivia had 18 stickers. She gave $\frac{1}{6}$ of them to a friend. How many stickers did she give away?

10. A pizza was cut into 8 equal slices. Sofia ate $\frac{5}{8}$ of the pizza. How many slices did she eat?
