Teacher's Guide

- Quick implementation tips
 - Remind students to identify key words before looking at the answer choices.
 - Encourage students to explain why the other three equations do not fit.
 - Review the meanings of addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division in word problems.
- Differentiation strategies
 - Provide an operation clue chart for students who need extra support.
 - Allow students to work with a partner to discuss each choice before answering.
 - Challenge advanced students to write a matching word problem for one of the incorrect equations.
- Engagement ideas
 - Turn each question into a class vote by having students hold up A, B, C, or D cards.
 - Ask volunteers to justify their choices using math vocabulary.
- Extension activities
 - Have students solve the problems after choosing the correct equation.
 - Ask students to create a new multiple-choice question with one correct equation and three distractors.
