Question Finder

Directions: Read each fraction situation and the completed equation. Choose the question that matches the equation. Circle the correct letter.

- Mia drank $\frac{2}{5}$ of a bottle of water before lunch and $\frac{1}{5}$ after lunch.
Equation: $\frac{2}{5} + \frac{1}{5} = \frac{3}{5}$
 - How many bottles did Mia drink?
 - How much water was left in the bottle?
 - How much water did Mia drink altogether?
- A ribbon is 1 yard long. Ben used $\frac{3}{8}$ yard.
Equation: $1 - \frac{3}{8} = \frac{5}{8}$
 - How much ribbon did Ben use?
 - How much ribbon is left?
 - How many ribbons does Ben have?
- A recipe uses $\frac{3}{4}$ cup of oats for each batch. Emma makes 4 batches.
Equation: $4 \times \frac{3}{4} = 3$
 - How many cups of oats are needed for 4 batches?
 - How many batches can be made with $\frac{3}{4}$ cup?
 - How much oats are left after baking?
- Noah has 2 yards of string. He cuts it into pieces that are $\frac{1}{4}$ yard long.
Equation: $2 \div \frac{1}{4} = 8$
 - How long is each piece?
 - How many pieces can Noah make?
 - How much string is left?
- Ava walked $\frac{5}{6}$ mile in the morning and $\frac{1}{6}$ mile in the afternoon.
Equation: $\frac{5}{6} + \frac{1}{6} = 1$
 - How much farther does Ava need to walk?
 - How far did Ava walk in the morning?
 - How far did Ava walk altogether?
- A bucket holds $\frac{7}{8}$ gallon of water. $\frac{2}{8}$ gallon is poured out.
Equation: $\frac{7}{8} - \frac{2}{8} = \frac{5}{8}$
 - How much water was poured out?
 - How much water is left in the bucket?
 - How many buckets are needed?
- A class made 18 bookmarks. $\frac{2}{3}$ of them were decorated with stars.
Equation: $18 \times \frac{2}{3} = 12$
 - How many bookmarks were made?
 - How many students decorated bookmarks?
 - How many bookmarks have stars?
- Lily has $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of fabric. She cuts it into pieces that are $\frac{1}{8}$ yard long.
Equation: $\frac{3}{4} \div \frac{1}{8} = 6$
 - How many pieces can Lily cut?
 - How much fabric did Lily start with?
 - How long is each piece?
