	2. A recipe needs $2\frac{1}{2}$ cups of flour. Ethan has $1\frac{3}{4}$ cups. How much more flour does he need?
	3. A ribbon is 6 feet long. Each piece must be $\frac{3}{4}$ foot long. How many pieces can be cut?
	4. Nora read $\frac{2}{5}$ of a book on Monday. She wants to know how many pages that is in a 150-page book.
	5. A tank holds $\frac{7}{8}$ gallon of water. $\frac{1}{4}$ gallon is poured out. How much water remains?
	6. A baker used $\frac{3}{8}$ cup of sugar for one batch of cookies. He made 4 batches. How much sugar did he use in all?
	7. Sam has $\frac{5}{6}$ yard of fabric. He cuts it into pieces that are $\frac{1}{6}$ yard long. How many pieces does he make?
	8. Olivia finished $\frac{1}{3}$ of her homework before dinner and $\frac{2}{9}$ after dinner. What fraction of her homework did she finish altogether?
	9. A board is $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet long. A piece measuring $1\frac{3}{4}$ feet is cut off. How long is the board now?
	10. A class planted 24 flowers. $\frac{5}{8}$ of the flowers are tulips. How many tulips did the class plant?
