- 1. The region of Gaul becomes part of the Roman Empire.
- 2. The Normans invade from the north and settle in parts of France.
- 3. The Palace of Versailles becomes the royal center of government.
- 4. The French Revolution leads to major political and social changes.
- 5. France expands its global influence during the Age of Exploration.
- 6. The construction of the Eiffel Tower begins in Paris.
- 7. France becomes one of the first members of the European Union.
- 8. High speed trains known as TGV begin connecting major French cities.

Teacher's Guide

Purpose

- Help grades 8 to 10 develop chronological thinking and historical sequencing skills.
- Show how geographic and cultural developments shape France over time.

During the Activity

- Encourage students to identify clues such as ancient, medieval, or modern periods.
- Allow students to discuss events with partners before numbering.
- Remind students to think about technological progress when placing more recent events.

Engagement Ideas

- Show images of the Roman Empire, Versailles, the Eiffel Tower, and TGV trains.
