Teacher's Guide

Purpose

Differentiation Tips

- Offer a short fact sheet describing major cultural regions.
- Allow students with writing challenges to respond orally first.
- Challenge advanced students to compare France's patterns to another country.

Engagement Ideas

- Ask students to vote on which cultural region they find most interesting and explain why.
- Hold a quick debate on whether urbanization strengthens or weakens cultural identity.
