Directions: Read the passage about the physical geography of France. Then answer the questions that follow.

France has a wide variety of physical features that shape daily life, travel, and culture. In the southeast, the **Alps** rise sharply, creating high peaks, cold temperatures, and popular winter sports areas. To the south and west, wide coastal plains meet the **Mediterranean Sea** and the **Atlantic Ocean**, bringing mild winters and warm summers. Major rivers such as the **Seine**, **Loire**, **Garonne**, and **Rhône** help connect cities to farmland and transportation routes. Across the country, climate zones vary from **oceanic** in the northwest, to **Mediterranean** in the south, to **mountain climates** in the highest elevations.

- 6. How might life be different for people living in mountain climates compared to people living near the Mediterranean coast
- 7. Why do you think rivers help connect cities across France Provide a complete explanation.
- 8. Based on the passage, which physical feature do you think has the biggest effect on tourism in France Explain your reasoning.
