

Imagining Life in 2050 Answer Key

- **Requirement:** Students' paragraphs should use **at least 5–7 verbs in the future continuous tense** correctly.
- **Examples of acceptable answers:**
 - *In 2050, robots **will be helping** with housework.*
 - *People **will be working** fewer hours and spending more time with family.*
 - *We **will be communicating** through holograms.*
 - *I **will be exploring** other planets with scientists.*
 - *Children **will be playing** with advanced virtual reality toys.*

Example (Model Paragraph):

In 2050, people **will be flying** in cars instead of driving them. Students **will be learning** in virtual classrooms from anywhere in the world. Scientists **will be discovering** cures for more diseases. Families **will be living** in smart houses that talk to them. I **will be traveling** around the world with my friends. We **will be speaking** many languages using instant translator devices. Everyone **will be enjoying** a healthier, cleaner planet.

Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Purpose:** This activity combines **grammar practice** with **imaginative writing**, making the tense meaningful.
- **Assessment Tip:** Check that students consistently use **will be + verb-ing** and not simple future forms.
- **Differentiation:**
 - For younger learners, provide a **word bank** of verbs (e.g., working, studying, traveling, building, exploring).
 - For advanced learners, encourage **longer paragraphs** and a wider variety of verbs.
- **Extension:** Students can read their paragraphs aloud, and the class can imagine together what the world in 2050 will look like.
