Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Purpose of Activity:** Students learn how to shift from **simple future** (a definite action) to **future continuous** (an ongoing action at a specific future time).
- **Common Errors:** Students may forget to add "be" or may forget the "-ing" ending on verbs.
- **Extension Activity:** Have students write 3 of their own simple future sentences and then rewrite them into the future continuous tense. This reinforces mastery.
