3. **A.** Proper structure: "will be traveling."

6. **B.** "will be performing" shows future continuous.

Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Why this matters:** Future continuous tense helps students describe actions that will be in progress at a certain point in the future.
- **Teaching Tip:** Emphasize the formula → *will + be + verb(-ing)*. Encourage students to look for both the **helping verbs** ("will be") and the **-ing verb ending**.
- **Extension:** Ask students to write two multiple-choice questions of their own to quiz a partner, reinforcing peer learning.
