Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Skill reinforced:** Students see how **sentence beginnings and endings** combine naturally in the **future continuous tense**.
- **Tip for differentiation:** Allow advanced students to create their own sentence beginnings and endings, then swap with a partner to solve.
- **Common mistakes:** Students may accidentally match with endings that don't logically connect. Remind them that the tense must be **future continuous** and the meaning must make sense.
- **Extension idea:** After matching, have students rewrite 3 of the sentences in their notebooks and illustrate what will be happening.
