

Continuous Conjugations Answer Key

Verb: work

- I will have been working
- You will have been working
- He/She/It will have been working
- We will have been working
- You (plural) will have been working
- They will have been working

Verb: study

- I will have been studying
- You will have been studying
- He/She/It will have been studying
- We will have been studying
- You (plural) will have been studying
- They will have been studying

Verb: play

- I will have been playing
- You will have been playing
- He/She/It will have been playing
- We will have been playing
- You (plural) will have been playing
- They will have been playing

Verb: read

- I will have been reading
- You will have been reading
- He/She/It will have been reading
- We will have been reading
- You (plural) will have been reading
- They will have been reading

Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Why this activity works:** Verb charts help students **see the consistent pattern** across all pronouns, reinforcing that the form does not change with subject.
- **Key Teaching Tip:** Stress that only the **verb ending (-ing)** changes, while "will have been" stays constant. This reduces errors.
- **Common Pitfall:** Students sometimes omit "been." Drill the rhythm: *will-have-been-doing*.
- **Extension Idea:** After the chart, assign pairs of students different verbs (e.g., *write, sing, build, drive*). Have them fill in mini-charts and then create **oral practice questions** using their verbs.
