Teacher Notes / Guide

- Why this activity works: Dialog writing encourages creative output while
 ensuring correct use of the tense in context-rich situations. Students move
 beyond drills into meaningful communication.
- Key Reminder for Students: Each verb must follow the full structure:
 will + have been + verb(-ing).
- **Teaching Tip:** Before writing, brainstorm verbs with the class (e.g., *study*, *train*, *work*, *play*, *read*, *travel*). This gives students a word bank to use.
- Extension Idea: After writing, have pairs perform their dialogues for the class. Peers can underline or circle the future perfect continuous verbs they hear, reinforcing listening skills as well.
