Will Have Been Predicting Answer Key

1. By 10:00 p.m., the students **will have been studying** for eight hours.
2. By next summer, Emma **will have been living** in Paris for four years.
3. By 8:00 p.m., the fans **will have been waiting** for five hours.
4. By December, the builders **will have been repairing** the road for eleven months.
5. By the time we reach the peak, we **will have been hiking** all day.
6. By 5:00 p.m., Sarah **will have been practicing** piano for several hours.
7. By the end of the year, the scientists **will have been researching** for five years.
8. By next Friday, the workers **will have been working** at the shop for one month.
9. By midnight, she **will have been driving** for six hours.
10. When the concert ends, the band **will have been performing** on stage for two hours.

Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Purpose of this activity:** Students practice **imagining future durations** of ongoing actions, which is the exact purpose of the **future perfect continuous tense**.
- **Common Errors:**
 - Forgetting *been* (e.g., "will have studying" - wrong).
 - Using *past or present time markers* instead of future.
- **Strategy:** Encourage students to underline the **time marker** in each scenario first (e.g., *by December*, *by 8:00 p.m.*, *by next summer*). This helps anchor the tense.
- **Extension Idea:** Have students **create their own scenarios** (e.g., "By the time I turn 20, I will have been...") and swap with a partner to predict for each other.
