### Teacher Notes / Guide

- **Why this activity works:** Students practice identifying **grammatical errors** and correcting them, which strengthens their understanding of the “**will have been + verb(-ing)**” structure.
- **Common Mistakes Highlighted:**
  - Mixing auxiliary verbs (*will has, will been*).
  - Dropping “been” (*will have studying*).
  - Using incorrect verb forms (*read instead of reading*).
- **Teaching Tip:** Encourage students to say the structure out loud: *will - have - been - verb-ing*. This rhythm helps prevent errors.
- **Extension Idea:** After sorting, have students **create two correct and two incorrect examples of their own**, then exchange with a partner to solve.
