

Future Perfect Passage Answer Key

Corrected Passage

By the time next summer begins, our soccer team **will have played** in three tournaments. We **will have won** two of them and **will have scored** more than twenty goals. Our coach says that by then, we **will have practiced** together for almost a year. By the end of the season, each player **will have learned** new skills and **will have improved** in speed and teamwork.

Teacher Notes:

- This activity emphasizes how **future perfect tense** expresses actions completed *before another future time or event*.
- Common student errors include:
 - Using **"will" + base form** instead of **"will have" + past participle** (*will win* → *will have won*).
 - Incorrect auxiliaries (*will has played* instead of *will have played*).
 - Mixing in progressive forms (*will improving* instead of *will have improved*).
- Encourage students to highlight **time markers** (*by the time, by then, by the end of*) - these are signals for the **future perfect tense**.
- Extension: Have students write a short paragraph about their personal goals (e.g., "By next year, I will have joined..."), then swap with a partner to edit.
