## **Future Perfect Passage Answer Key**

## **Corrected Passage**

By the time next summer begins, our soccer team will have played in three tournaments. We will have won two of them and will have scored more than twenty goals. Our coach says that by then, we will have practiced together for almost a year. By the end of the season, each player will have learned new skills and will have improved in speed and teamwork.

## **Teacher Notes:**

- This activity emphasizes how **future perfect tense** expresses actions completed before another future time or event.
- Common student errors include:
  - Using "will" + base form instead of "will have" + past participle (will win → will have won).
  - o Incorrect auxiliaries (will has played instead of will have played).
  - Mixing in progressive forms (will improving instead of will have improved).
- Encourage students to highlight time markers (by the time, by then, by the
  end of) these are signals for the future perfect tense.
- Extension: Have students write a short paragraph about their personal goals (e.g., "By next year, I will have joined..."), then swap with a partner to edit.
