

Future Perfect Options Answer Key

1. B → **will have finished**
2. A → **will have written**
3. C → **will have read**
4. D → **will have traveled**
5. C → **will have completed**
6. A → **will have known**
7. D → **will have cooked**
8. B → **will have repaired**
9. A → **will have built**
10. D → **will have seen**

Teacher Notes:

- The **future perfect tense** always follows: **will have + past participle**.
- Wrong answers are designed to highlight **common mistakes**:
 - Mixing with simple future (*will finished*).
 - Using incorrect auxiliary (*will has*).
 - Using base or continuous forms (*will traveling*).
- A quick mini-lesson after grading: Have students create their own multiple-choice question with three incorrect distractors, so they see why the correct form is best.
