Teacher's Guide

Purpose

- Help students in grades 3 to 5 learn where well-known German landmarks are located.
- Strengthen recognition of major cities in Germany and their cultural features.
- Build early geography skills in a simple matching format.

Instructional Tips

- Review pronunciation of city names to build confidence.
- Encourage students to use process of elimination for unfamiliar matches.
- Ask students to explain why a landmark might be important or famous.

Extension Activities

- Have students write two sentences about one landmark using facts from the map or classroom resources.
- Ask students to compare two German cities and identify what makes each one unique.
- Encourage students to draw one landmark and label the city where it is found.
