## **Teacher Guide / Notes**

- Purpose: Mini dialogues allow students to see gerunds and infinitives in conversational contexts, making practice more meaningful.
- Key teaching points:
  - o enjoy, admit, can't stand, mind  $\rightarrow$  always followed by **gerunds**.
  - $\circ$  want, decide, hope, offer, promise  $\rightarrow$  always followed by **infinitives**.
  - $\circ$  stop, remember, forget, try  $\to$  can use both forms but meanings change (highlight in class discussion).
- Extension idea: After filling in blanks, have students perform the dialogues
  in pairs, then create their own short conversations using at least 2 gerunds
  and 2 infinitives.
