Teacher Guide / Notes

- **Purpose**: Sorting encourages students to evaluate grammar instead of only producing it. This helps them notice patterns more deeply.
- Error focus:
 - o enjoy, avoid, suggest, admit, finish, can't stand \rightarrow always + gerund.
 - o decide, hope, promise, want, agree \rightarrow always + infinitive.
- **Extension idea**: After sorting, ask students to:
- 1. **Group the main verbs** into "gerund verbs" and "infinitive verbs."
- 2. Create one original **Correct** sentence and one **Incorrect** sentence (intentionally wrong) for a partner to fix.
