### Matches

1. enjoy → C. going for a walk in the park (gerund)
2. decide → D. to buy a new bicycle (infinitive)
3. suggest → G. studying late at night (gerund)
4. hope → A. to help a friend with homework (infinitive)
5. avoid → J. eating too much junk food (gerund)
6. agree → F. to meet at the coffee shop (infinitive)
7. can't stand → B. watching movies on the weekend (gerund)
8. offer → H. to drive us to the airport (infinitive)
9. admit → E. breaking the vase accidentally (gerund)
10. want → I. to get better grades (infinitive)

### Teacher Guide / Notes

- **Gerund verbs:** enjoy, suggest, avoid, can't stand, admit.
- **Infinitive verbs:** decide, hope, agree, offer, want.
- This exercise reinforces memorization of **verb patterns** and provides contextual complements instead of just single words.
- **Extension idea:** After matching, ask students to write a full sentence for each pair (e.g., *I enjoy going for a walk in the park*).
- To challenge advanced learners, include verbs that can take **both forms with different meanings** (e.g., *remember, stop, try*) in a follow-up round.
