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## **Heroes Of Words Answer Key**

Student answers will vary, but should show clear understanding. Examples include:

- **Liberty**: Being free to make choices; not controlled by someone else Sentence example: People came to America seeking liberty.
- Nation: A group of people living in the same country with one government
  - Sentence example: Our nation celebrates its history on Independence Day.
- **Freedom**: The right to act, speak, or think without unfair limits Sentence example: Freedom allows people to share their ideas.
- **Equality**: Everyone has the same rights and is treated fairly Sentence example: Equality means people are respected no matter who they are.
- **Honor**: Showing respect for someone's courage, actions, or character *Sentence example: We honor heroes who protect our country.*

## Teachers should check that:

- Definitions reflect core meaning
- Sentences match the word's idea
- Answers are not copied directly from a dictionary

## Teacher's Guide

- Model one word together before students work independently
- Provide a short mini-lesson describing how Abraham Lincoln used these ideas
- Allow discussion or partner sharing before writing to build confidence

## Differentiation

- Offer word banks, picture cues, or sentence starters for developing writers
- Challenge advanced students to add a second example sentence using context clues
- Support English learners with simplified definitions or synonyms prior to writing
