### Sample Responses

1. **Crucifixion** - The death of Jesus on the cross.  
*Sentence:* The story of the crucifixion is remembered on Good Friday.
2. **Sacrifice** - Giving up something valuable for the good of others.  
*Sentence:* Her sacrifice helped her friend succeed.
3. **Atonement** - Making things right after doing wrong.  
*Sentence:* He showed atonement by apologizing sincerely.
4. **Redemption** - Being saved or forgiven from wrongdoing.  
*Sentence:* The act of redemption brings hope and peace.
5. **Compassion** - Deep care for someone who is hurting.

### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - For struggling writers, provide sentence starters or short definitions to match.
  - For advanced learners, encourage them to write two sentences per word-one literal, one reflective.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Play a "Faith Word Swap" game-students explain a word without saying it, and classmates guess which term it is.
  - Use art integration: students write each word inside a symbolic shape (e.g., cross, heart, or light beam).
