Sample Responses

- Crucifixion The death of Jesus on the cross.
 Sentence: The story of the crucifixion is remembered on Good Friday.
- 2. **Sacrifice** Giving up something valuable for the good of others. *Sentence:* Her sacrifice helped her friend succeed.
- 3. **Atonement** Making things right after doing wrong. *Sentence:* He showed atonement by apologizing sincerely.
