Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Symbol interpretation, color symbolism, and religious literacy.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Provide visual examples of each color in liturgical art or vestments for younger students.
 - Challenge advanced learners to research how these colors are used differently in other Christian traditions.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students design a symbolic Good Friday banner using black, red, and purple, with short written explanations.
 - Create a "Color Walk" in class-post each color's meaning on a wall and let students rotate and discuss.
- **Extension Options:**
 - Ask students to write a reflective paragraph titled *"If Faith Had a Color..."*
