Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Critical thinking, comprehension, and distinguishing between historical information and religious belief.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - Review the difference between *fact* and *faith* before the activity using simple examples (e.g., "The sun rises in the east" vs. "We believe kindness always wins").
 - For higher grades, invite discussion about how both history and faith can coexist in cultural understanding.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Use a "Fact or Faith" line-up game: students move to one side of the room for "Fact" and the other for "Faith."
 - Have students explain their reasoning for each choice to encourage deeper analysis.
- **Extension Options:**
 - Ask students to write two of their own statements about Good Friday- one factual, one faith-based- and exchange with a classmate to identify.
 - Connect to history or art lessons by examining how Good Friday has been depicted differently in cultures across time.
