Writing Clear, Smart Prompts

Asking the right question makes all the difference. If you ask Google Gemini something too short or vague, it might give you an answer that's too broad or not what you wanted. But if you ask a question that's clear, specific, and detailed, Gemini can give you a much more useful response.

Think of it like ordering at a restaurant. If you just say, "I want food," you might get anything! But if you say, "I'd like a cheeseburger with lettuce, tomato, and ketchup," you'll probably get exactly what you hoped for. Asking good questions is the same - and that's what you'll practice today.
