#	Question	Correct / Verified Answer	Notes for Teachers
1	When did humans first walk on the moon?	<b>July 20, 1969</b> - Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin walked on the moon during NASA's Apollo 11 mission.	Some AI tools may list the wrong date or forget to mention both astronauts.
2	What causes earthquakes?	<b>Movement of tectonic plates</b> - when plates in Earth's crust shift or collide, energy is released as seismic waves.	Gemini might oversimplify or skip mention of tectonic plates or seismic energy.
3	Who invented the telephone?	<b>Alexander Graham Bell</b> , in 1876.	Gemini might mention others who worked on similar inventions (like Elisha Gray), which is partly accurate.
4	What is the largest ocean on Earth?	<b>The Pacific Ocean.</b>	Straightforward - most AI tools get this one right.
5	How many continents are there on Earth?	<b>Seven:</b> Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe, and Australia.	Some regions teach six if Europe and Asia are combined as Eurasia - both perspectives can be discussed.
6	What is photosynthesis?	<b>The process by which plants make food (sugar) using sunlight, carbon dioxide, and water.</b>	Gemini might include details about oxygen release or chlorophyll, which adds accuracy.
