Seed to Sprout Answer Key

- 1. Leo gave the seed water \rightarrow c. The sprout began to grow.
- 2. The sun shone on the soil \rightarrow b. The soil stayed warm.
- 3. Leo planted a seed in the soil \rightarrow a. A sprout grew bigger.

Teacher Guide:

This worksheet helps students connect what happens (effect) with why it happens (cause). Encourage them to look for action words (like "gave," "shone," "planted") to find the causes, and results (like "grew," "stayed warm") to find the effects. The drawing activity makes the cause-effect link more concrete by letting them visualize the plant's growth.
